

WHAT IS AN ARTIST'S "STUDY"

SMALL PRELIMINARY DRAWINGS OR ROUGH SKETCHES ARE FREQUENTLY CREATED AS A PREPARATORY IDEA FOR A LARGER PIECE. THIS TYPE OF DRAWING YEARS AGO MIGHT OFTEN BE CONSIDERED "SECONDARY" BY COLLECTORS. BUT TODAY IN THE ART WORLD, AN ARTIST'S "STUDY" IS VIEWED AS A COMPLETED WORK ON ITS OWN — AN ORIGINAL LITTLE GEM.

GENERALLY ARTISTS "STUDIES" ARE SMALL IN SIZE, UP TO 10 X 12 WHICH MAKES THEM EASY TO FRAME AND REQUIRE LESS WALL SPACE FOR HANGING.

A SINGLE ARTIST "STUDY" MAY ALSO INCLUDE MORE THAN ONE MEDIUM — FOR INSTANCE A ROUGH PENCIL SKETCH OR QUICK BRUSH PAINTING ALONG WITH HAND WRITTEN NOTES ABOUT THE SUBJECT MATTER.

BOTH VINTAGE FINE ART "STUDIES" AND NEW ARTIST "STUDIES" OFFER THE COLLECTOR A WONDERFUL OPTION FOR ORIGINAL ART.
